# ART

(All materials and equipment provided)

A series of 6 informal Art sessions in which we will work through the basic stages of constructing your painting so by the end of the 6 sessions you will have a finished piece of work to take home and be proud of!

13 JANUARY...DECISIONS DECISIONS.

Choose your subject and medium (watercolour, acrylic, pastel, pen & wash or mixed media) then we will begin with a sketch to work from.

10 FEBRUARY...A GOOD GROUNDING.

Working from your sketch we will begin with the background to your painting.

10 MARCH...THE MIDDLE GROUND.

Having completed your background we will carry on blocking in your painting giving it more substance.

7 APRIL...A LITTLE DETAIL.

In this session we can start to add more detail to your work.

5 MAY...FINISHING TOUCHES.

By now you should be almost finished but need to add those finishing touches.

2 JUNE...PRESENTATION.

Our last session will let you catch up if you're not quite finished and we will look at how to present your finished work to show it off to its best advantage.

# CRAFT

(all materials and equipment provided)

A series of 6 fun Craft sessions in which we will use a variety of craft techniques to make a decorative bowl for you to take home.

20 JANUARY...PAPER MACHE.

Not the squidgy paste mix you remember from childhood...more finesse and less mess! This will be the base for your bowl.

17 FEBRUARY...GROUNDINGS.

Preparing the inside and outside of your bowl with different grounds ready for the next two stages.

17 MARCH...DECOUPAGE.

Traditional Decoupage to cover the outside of your bowl making it as pretty, subtle or colourful as you like.

14 APRIL...CATCHING UP.

Sessions 1 to 3 are more than likely to run over so this is a week to catch up ready for the next stage.

12 MAY...GILDING.

Make the inside of your bowl gleam by gilding it with metal leaf...just nobody sneeze!

9 JUNE...VARNISHING.

Make a start on varnishing your bowl. Ideally it should have between 7 and 10 coats so we can give it a 1st coat to protect it until you can do the rest!
